Eggplants

- **Fairytale**

Fairytale eggplants produce 2-4 inch fruits that can be harvested in clusters. These white & purple fruits have few seeds and a wonderful, non-bitter flavor. The plant requires full sun and daily watering; keep soil moist but not saturated. These 1-2 foot plants should be grown on stakes for best yield. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Petch Siam**

Petch Siam eggplants produce 1 inch fruits that can be harvested in clusters with a distinct veining pattern. These green, round fruits are perfect for flavourful dishes like curry since they absorb spices well. The plant requires full sun and daily watering. These 1-2 foot plants should be grown on stakes for best yield. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Night Shadow**

Night Shadow eggplants produce dark purple, teardrop-shaped eggplants that can be used in a variety of dishes. The plant requires full sun and daily watering; keep soil moist but not saturated. These plants should be grown on stakes for best yield. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Millionaire**

Millionaire eggplants produce thin, 10 inch fruits that can be harvested in clusters. These purple fruits go great in stir-fry dishes. The plant requires full sun and daily watering; keep soil moist but not saturated. These plants should be grown on stakes for best yield. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Fond May**

Fond May eggplants produce thin, 10 inch fruits. These magenta fruits go great in flavorful stir-fry dishes. The plant requires full sun and daily watering; keep soil moist but not saturated. These plants should be grown on stakes for best yield. Sold in 4" square pots.



Mini-Greens

- **Amaranth Bicolor**

Bicolor Amaranth has beautiful green and red leaves filled with Vitamins A&C. Its mild, earthy flavor goes great in salads, soups, and sauteed dishes. It can be harvested by cutting the bottom of the leaves with scissors as soon as they develop. Requires full sun and frequent watering; puny any flowering buds. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Red Gruner Purslane**

These microgreens have a mild, spinach-like flavor perfect for sprucing up your salads and sandwiches. Grow in a greenhouse with sufficient natural light/supplemental lighting; bottom water or mist to maintain even moisture (do not allow sowing mix to dry out). Harvest at ½-2" in height, or once the cotyledons have fully developed or first true leaves begin to emerge. All come potted in 4" square pots.



Okra

- **Clemson Spineless #80**

These rich, green pods stay spineless and non-woody, and boast ornamental flowers and attractive leaves. Prior to planting, soak the okra in water for 12 to 18 hours. Plant in warm soil; requires full sun; water 1 inch per week. Most tender and flavorful if harvested at 3-4". All come potted in 4" square pots.



Hot Peppers

*The spiciness of hot peppers can range from relatively mild (i.e. poblanos) to very hot (i.e. habaneros) to the hottest (ghost peppers). All come potted in 4" square pots.

- **Flaming Jade**

Flaming Jade peppers stalks produce 6-inch, super spicy green peppers. The peppers can be eaten cooked or raw making them perfect for salsas, hot sauces, marinades. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Perfect center for container gardens; should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Peter**

Peter pepper plants produce 4 inch, unusually-shaped, spicy, red peppers. The peppers are best eaten cooked or powdered making them perfect for chillies and marinades. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Bolivian Rainbow**

Bolivian Rainbow Pepper plants produce small, spicy peppers in many colors. The color indicates ripeness with yellow being unripe and purple being perfectly ripe; however, they can be harvested any time after turning bright yellow. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Chichen Itza**

Chichen itza peppers are a fiery orange habanero-type pepper with high heat. The 3 inch peppers are perfect for pickling, salsa, hot sauce, and seasoning powder. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Inferno**

Inferno Pepper plants produce 8-inch spicy red peppers with sweet underlying flavors. They are perfect for roasting, pickling, and frying, and dish toppings. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Jalafuego**

Jalafuego peppers are a variety of Jalapeno peppers that start green then turn red once reaching maximum spiciness. They go great in salsas, nachos, guacamoles, and chilis. They require full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Habanero**

Habanero pepper plants produce 4-6 inch spicy orange peppers with sweet underlying flavors. They can be eaten fresh or cooked and are perfect for roasting, pickling, and frying, and topping dishes. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Pathfinder**

Pathfinder Serrano peppers produce 4-5 inch hot peppers perfect for salsas, nachos, guacamoles, and chilis. These plants can tolerate a wide range of temperatures, but need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Spicy Slice**

Spicy Slice peppers produce 4-5 inch hot peppers perfect for salsas, nachos, guacamoles, and chilis. These plants can tolerate a wide range of temperatures, but need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Tabasco**

Tabasco peppers are the chili peppers used in Tabasco sauce. The plants produce pungent red peppers around 2 inches in length. They can be eaten fresh or cooked and are perfect for roasting, pickling, and frying, and topping dishes. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Ghost (Naga Jolokia)**

Ghost Peppers are one of the spiciest peppers. They require full sun, warmth, and moist soils. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Arapaho (Cheyenne)**

Arapaho Cheyenne plants produce 8 inch hot peppers with a sweet taste. They are served well grilled or as powder seasoning. This variety requires full sun and water every few days. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Altiplano Serrano**

Altiplano Serrano peppers produce 4-5 inch hot peppers perfect for salsas, nachos, guacamoles, and chilis. These plants can tolerate a wide range of temperatures, but need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support. Sold in 4" square pots.



Bell & Banana Peppers

- **Antebellum**

Antebellum Pepper plants produce green Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Bayonet**

Bayonet pepper plants produce green Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **King Arthur**

King Arther pepper plants produce green and red Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Majestic Red**

Majestic Red pepper plants produce red Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need

full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **PS 09941819X5R**

PS 09941819X5R pepper plants produce extra-large, green Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Sun Haven**

Sun Haven pepper plants produce sweet, yellow Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Turnpike**

Turnpike pepper plants produce green Bell peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Sweet Sunset Banana Peppers**

Sweet Sunset pepper plants produce red, orange, and yellow Banana peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



- **Mama Mia Giallo**

Mama Mia Giallo pepper plants produce yellow Banana peppers. They prefer warm temperatures, need full sun and bi-daily watering. Should be grown with a trellis or cage for support in well-drained soils. Sold in 4" square pots.



Tomatillo

- **TomaVerde**

Early maturing green tomatillo perfect for use in salsa or Mexican cooking. Harvest weekly with husks attached into containers or 10-lb flats when the fruit is still firm, bright green, and filling the papery husk. Needs full sun and frequent watering. All come potted in 4" square pots.



Large Tomatoes

- **Lemon Boy Plus**

Lemon Boy Plus tomatoes have a sweet, tangy flavor. Harvest when bright lemon-yellow to deeper golden-yellow or a bit under ripe if you prefer a more acidic flavor. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.




- **Jolene**

Jolene tomatoes produce large, beefsteak tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns bright red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Black Krim**

Black Krim tomatoes produce large, beefsteak tomatoes that vary from red to purple. Harvest once the fruit begins to turn colors. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Brandy Wine**

Brandy Wine tomatoes produce large, pumpkin-shaped tomatoes that vary from green to red. Harvest once the fruit begins to turn yellow, or wait until redness develops if you desire. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Persimmon**

Persimmon tomatoes produce large, rosy orange tomatoes, similar to a persimmon. Harvest once the fruit begins to turn orangey-red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Purple Boy**

Purple boy Black Krim tomatoes produce large, pumpkin-shaped tomatoes that vary from green to red. Harvest once the fruit begins to turn purple or deep red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Pink Delicious**

Pink Delicious tomatoes produce sweet, pink beefsteak tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns bright pinkish red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Mr. Stripey**

Mr. Stripey tomatoes produce large, pumpkin-shaped tomatoes that vary from yellow to pinkish-red. Harvest once the fruit begins to turn purple or deep red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Amelia**

Tomatoes offer several health benefits that contribute to brain, heart, and gut health! Needs full sun and frequent watering; moderate to heavy pruning yields extra large fruit. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Bella Rosa**

These tomatoes boast a delicious sweet flavor with a good balance between sweetness and tartness. Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Celebrity Plus**


These deep red, large fruits are firm and pack a punch of flavor. Grow on the ground, cage or staked. Needs full sun and frequent watering; pruning not recommended. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Sanibel**

This tomato is a large 8-12oz variety bursting with flavor due to its high sugar/acid balance.

Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Sunny Boy**

With its bright yellow exterior and rich sweetness, this tomato definitely lives up to its name! Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.




- **Top Gun**

Tomatoes offer several health benefits that contribute to brain, heart, and gut health! Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Saybrook**

Tomatoes offer several health benefits that contribute to brain, heart, and gut health! Needs full sun and frequent watering; do NOT prune. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Better Boy Plus**

These tomatoes are large, globe-shaped fruits averaging 1 lb. or more. Needs full sun and frequent watering; grow on ground or stakes. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Big Beef Plus**

Early red beefsteak-type tomato with fruits weighing 8-12 oz. Needs full sun and frequent watering; best if grown on stakes. Harvest when the tomatoes begin to show blushes of pink and the bottom of the fruit starts to soften.



- **Grandeur**

Deep red, smooth fruit with amazing taste! Needs full sun and frequent watering; best if grown on stakes. Harvest when the tomatoes have a green-shouldered trait to mark vine-ripe readiness.



Cherry Tomatoes

- **Sunsugar**

Sunsugar tomatoes produce orange, sweet cherry tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns orange. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Yellow Pear**

Yellow Pear plants produce yellow pear-shaped tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns yellow. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Midnight Snack**

Midnight Snack vines produce deep purple cherry tomatoes that turn red with ripeness. Harvest once the fruit turns a deep purple-red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Sunrise Bumble Bee**

Sunrise Bumble Bee tomatoes produce red-orange, tangy cherry tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns yellow and orange. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Clementine**

Clementine tomatoes produce orange, tangy cherry tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns orange, or for a more acidic taste, harvest while partly green. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Matt's Wild Cherry**

Matt's Wild Cherry tomatoes produce sweet, oval-shaped cherry tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns bright red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.




- **Indigo Cherry Drops**

Indigo Cherry Drop vines produce dark blue cherry tomatoes with anthocyanin coloration. Harvest once the fruit turns a deep purple. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Granadero**

Granadero tomatoes produce sweet, oval-shaped tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns bright red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Sakura**

Sakura tomatoes produce sweet, cherry tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns bright red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Favorita**

Favorita tomatoes produce sweet, oval-shaped cherry tomatoes. Harvest once the fruit turns bright red. Prune dead leaves and flowers; should be grown on wire cages or trellis. Flowers attract bees. Plant requires full sun and water daily.



- **Hybrid 46**

Large, elongated Roma type tomato perfect for sauces and canning. Grow in loamy, acidic soil; needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored red and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Plum Regal**

Large, elongated Roma type tomato perfect for sauces and canning. Grow in loamy, acidic soil; needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored red and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Juliet**

Grape-like tomatoes with a glossy, deep red color and great flavor fresh or cooked. Grow in loamy, acidic soil; needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored red and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Gabrielle**

Classic grape tomato with delicious flavor that's perfect for one-bite eating! Needs full sun and frequent watering; grow in a cage or on a stake. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored red and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.




- **Honeybee**

This golden yellow tomato may be small, but it packs in lots of sweetness! Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored yellow and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Super Sweet 100**

This tomato speaks for itself: these small, red cherry tomatoes are very sweet and boast a high Vitamin C content! Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored red and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Patio Choice yellow**

These small, bright yellow tomatoes have a sweet and mildly acidic taste. Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored yellow and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Red Robin**

These glossy, bright red fruits feature a delicious sweet-acid flavor and are an excellent source of Vitamin C and Vitamin A. Needs full sun and frequent watering. Harvest when the tomatoes are evenly colored yellow and firm. All come potted in 4" square pots.



Flowers

Cosmos

- **Early sensation mixed colors**

These tall Cosmos flowers bear beautiful daisy-like flowers of bright crimson, deep rose, pink, and white. They attract bees, butterflies, and other pollinators! Grows best in full sun and partial shade; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry); transplant or thin when the plants are 4" high. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Cosmic mix**

These daisy-like flowers boast vibrant hues of red, sunset orange, and yellow. Grows best in full sun and partial shade; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). Pinch the growing point when the plant is 1" tall to promote multi-stem growth and harvest when the flower buds begin to open but before pollination. All come potted in 4" square pots.



Marigold French

- **Bonanza Mix**

Boasting large and fragrant flowers in vibrant orange and yellow hues, these Bonanza marigolds will brighten up any outdoor or indoor space! Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). All come potted in 4" square pots.



Zinnia

- **Giant Dahlia Flowered Mix**

These Zinnia flowers are a must-need for your garden, boasting intense shades of yellow shades, rose shades, scarlet, green, orange, pink, red, purple, and coral. Attracts beneficial pollinators! Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). Harvest before the petals are completely open/when the stem is firm from the point of cut to just below the bloom. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Profusion Mix**

These Zinnia flowers are true to their name with their profusion of orange, cherry, red, and white hues that brighten up any space! Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies, and bees! Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). When cutting the blooms for a vase, trim off all the foliage. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Oklahoma Mixed colors**

Just like butterflies, hummingbirds, and bees, everyone is sure to love these classic double Zinnias boasting shades of crisp yellow, pink, scarlet, salmon, and white. Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). Cut the flowers for bouquets only when the flowers are freshly opened, making sure the stems are firm and holding the bloom upright. All come potted in 4" square pots.



Gomphrena

- **Ping Pong Mix**

These Gomphrena flowers bloom in beautiful ball-shaped blossoms in shades of deep amethyst purple, pastel lavender, and pure white. Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). All come potted in 4" square pots.



Vinca

- **Pacifica Mixed Colors**

Boasting vivid blooms of cherry red, coral, light pink, and white, these Vinca flowers make beautiful beds, borders, ground cover, baskets, or houseplants! Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). All come potted in 4" square pots.



Celosia

- **Chief Mix**

These flowers boasting hues of gold, rose, persimmon, and red shades are said to look like coral! Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). They are beautiful as cut flowers and can be used fresh & dried. Harvest when the flowers are fully developed, and stems are firm at the base of the bloom. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **New Look**

These flowers are an intense, deep red with dark, bronze-colored foliage that will catch anyone's eye! Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). Harvest when the flowers are fully developed, and stems are firm at the base of the bloom. All come potted in 4" square pots.



- **Prestige Scarlet**

True to their name, these flowers boast a deep scarlet hue and are beautiful for both bedding and cut flower displays. Grows best in full sun; needs 1-2 inches of water a week (keep the leaves dry). Harvest when the flowers are fully developed, and stems are firm at the base of the bloom. All come potted in 4" square pots.



Houston Native Plants

***These native plants have grown in Houston for thousands of years, so they are adapted to the climate and easy to maintain. In nature, these plants are critical to Houston's ecology. If you want to attract beautiful birds and butterflies to your yard, I recommend taking these home with you!**

- **Mealy Blue Sage**

Mealy Blue Sages are perennial flowers that produce a lovely sage scent. They are pollinated by bees and hummingbirds. They can tolerate a range of soils as long as they have full sun and semi-frequent watering. Cut the old flower stems to keep the plants lush. You can expect blooms from April to October.



- **Lady in Red Salvia (Scarlet Sage)**

Scarlet Sages are perennial flowers that produce a lovely sage scent. They are pollinated by bees and hummingbirds. They prefer sandy spoils with medium water and partial sun. Cut the old flower stems to keep the plants lush. You can expect bright red blooms year round.



- **Buttonbush**

Button Bushes are perennial shrubs that produce a white puff-ball flowers. They are pollinated by various bees and butterflies. They can tolerate a wide range of soils but prefer lots of watering and shade. Plant near water to attract ducks. You can expect blooms from July to September.



- **Strawberry Bush (Euonymus)**

American Strawberry Bushes are perennial, deciduous shrubs that produce modest green and purple flowers. Its fruits and seeds are eaten by birds and small mammals. They can tolerate a wide range of soils but prefer lots of watering and light shade. You can expect blooms from March to August.



- **Sweetspire**

Sweetspire plants are shrubs that produce spires of white flowers. They attract and are pollinated by birds. They prefer acidic soils, lots of watering, and light shade. As a defense to the cold, the plant will turn purplish-red in the winter. You can expect blooms from March to June.



- **Native Prairie Aster**

Native Prairie Asters produce delicate light-purple flowers. They are pollinated by bees and butterflies. These plants are drought resistant, prefer dry soils, sandy soils, and full sun. Cut the old flower stems to keep the plants lush. You can expect blooms from June to August.



- **Blue-eyed Grass**

Blue-eyed Perennial Grasses produce blue, starry flowers. They can tolerate a range of soils as long as they have partial sun and frequent watering. You can expect blooms from March to July.



- **Rattlesnake Master**

Rattlesnake Masters are perennial shrubs that produce a white puff-ball flowers. They are pollinated by various bees and butterflies. They can tolerate a wide range of soils but prefer frequent watering and full sun. You can expect blooms from May to August.



- **Turk's Cap**

Turk's Caps are perennial, deciduous shrubs that produce hibiscus-like red, bulbed flowers. Its fruits and seeds are eaten by birds, butterflies, and small mammals. Fruits, flowers, and leaves are safe to eat (Not Stems). They can tolerate a wide range of soils but prefer light watering and shade. You can expect blooms from May to November.



- **White Mist Flower**

White Mist Flower plants are shrubs that produce delicate bunches of white flowers. They attract hummingbirds and bees. They prefer well-drained soils and a sun-shade mix. Severely cut back the plant each winter for best blooming results in the spring/fall. You can expect blooms from April to Early December.



- **Carolina Jessamine**

Carolina Jessamine Vines produce bushy, bright-yellow trumpet flowers. It is a high-climbing vine, and should be planted with access to a fence, tree, or other means of support. This plant can tolerate warm and cold temperatures, making it low-maintenance. If you have honeybees, do not purchase this vine as the nectar is toxic when consumed as honey. You can expect blooms from December to May.



- **Crossvine, Tangerine Beauty**

Tangerine Beauty Crossvines produce sweet, sunset-colored trumpet flowers. It is a high-climbing woody vine, and should be planted with access to a fence, tree, or other means of support. The flowers attract hummingbirds and bees. As a defense to the cold, the plant will turn purplish-red in the winter. You can expect blooms from March to May.



- **Mexican Butterfly Vine**

Mexican Butterfly Vines produce bushy, bright-yellow butterfly-shaped flowers. It is a high-climbing vine, and should be planted with access to a fence, tree, or other means of support. This plant can tolerate warm, dry temperatures, making it low-maintenance. It needs full sun and blooms from May to September.



- **Inland Sea Oats**

Inland Sea Oats are very popular as a low-maintenance shade grass. They have been used to prevent soil erosion along streams. They can tolerate a range of soils as long as they have partial sun and frequent watering. You can expect blooms from March to July.



- **Mexican Mint Marigold**

Mexican Mint Marigold is a compact perennial that looks similar to marigolds. In the herb garden, it is highly ornamental with a profusion of small yellow flowers that bloom in late summer. As a kitchen herb, it has a scent of tarragon and a licorice-anise flavor that is a great seasoning for fish or chicken. This herb plant prefers full sun and well-draining soil, even sandy soils.



- **Louisiana Iris**

Louisiana Irises produce beautiful flowers in red, purple, and orange. These plants prefer wet marshy soils and full sun. You can expect blooms from May to June.



- **Pink Evening Primrose**

Pink Evening Primroses create beautifully delicate pink flowers. As their name suggests, the species open their flowers in the evening, closing them again early each morning. They are a perennial plant and can tolerate many soil types. They should have well-drained soil and be in full sun. Expect blooms from February to October.



- **Short-toothed Mountain Mint**

Short-toothed Mountain Mint produces lustrous leaves, silvery bracts and aromatic flowers that make it a popular choice for perennial flower gardens. The mint offers excellent pollinator support for both butterflies and bees. It's easy to grow in almost any average to fertile, well-drained soil, it does best in full sun, but will tolerate light shade. Expect blooms July to August. Edible and great for essential oils!
